Sunday Travel General Rules and Information

Players must be a registered Little League Player who participates in his/her Program.

The League is a 10U /12U Baseball Program played on regulation Little League fields.

Travel is involved and games will be scheduled by area, zones and or sites.

Participating in this League does not insure All Stars eligibility

It is our hope that all Players will have the chance to be involved in this Program.

To field a Team they may use Tryout, Coach picked, Board picked, Player registration.

A registration fee of about \$200 per team covers (5) Sundays. April 24th – June 12th
Umpire fees will be TEAM responsibility and shared by each team.

Each Team must provide at least six (6) balls per game. Game time limit will be one hour and forty minutes (1:45), complete the half inning, with a new Game time of every 2 hours.

Mission Statement

NY District 8 is proposing a **10U/12U** Sunday **District Chartered** Travel League. To provide additional Players, Teams, and Leagues the opportunity to play more Baseball with new Players and Coaches. This League will be rostered with above average, and advanced level of Players from our Leagues, who wish to play more Baseball. Players and Teams who are unable to afford the high cost and fees of Travel Ball

will benefit from this Program. This Program has been developed to afford our Players a new opportunity to prepare for Post Season and beyond, while continuing to enjoy the Little League experience. The Program will be directed and overseen by District 8 staff, and handled by a District Director, and the addition of an appointed Post Season Committee.

Sunday Travel General Rules and Information

Players must be a registered Little League Player who participates in his/her Program.

The League is a **10U /12U** Baseball Program played on regulation Little League fields. Travel is involved and games could be scheduled by area, zones and or sites.

All Little League Rules and Regulations will be followed with some exceptions; any changes will be discussed through Regional Headquarters.

Participating in this League does not insure All Stars eligibility.

Games will not be counted toward Tournament eligibility.

A League may place a Team(s) in a division, or in combination with up to three (3) Leagues.

We would like to be able to use expanded Roster sizes, with the possibility of ten to fourteen (**10-14**) Players per Team.

Coaches will be selected by the League(s).

It is our hope that all Players will have the chance to be involved in this Program.

To field a Team(s) a League may use a Tryout System, Coach picked, Board picked, Player registration, or another system.

A registration fee of approximately **\$200.00** per Team which covers **five (5)** Sundays. Dates include, **April 24th, May 1st, May 15th, June 5th, June 12th.**

Registration fee covers: District Charter, Accident Insurance, and General Liability for Leagues. Teams, Coaches, Manager, Players, and Officials who are involved with the operation of this League.

There is no rule on uniforms, your choice, **Little League patch on left shoulder**

A **Travel league patch** will be worn on the **right shoulder**

There will be a Need for Host Sites.

The Host Site League must provide at least two (2) fields, rest rooms, an operating concession stand, and use of batting cages, if available.

The Host Site will have limited input on scheduling, such as start times, which will depend on the number of Teams per Division participating.

Leagues MUST be ASAP Approved!

Field maintenance will be the Host League's or Host Sites responsibility.

Umpire fees will be TEAM responsibility and shared by each team.

Each Team must provide at least **six (6)** baseballs per game.

Game time limit will be one hour and forty minutes (1:45), complete the half inning, with a maximum time of one hour and forty-five minutes (1:45).

A team will play two **(2)** games in a day

A new game will begin every two (2) hours.

Communication will be via Zoom, Web Page, E-mail, Text, and Phone Blast.
